### WHITE WINE

- 1 Luis Felipe Edwards Lot 66 £21.50  
Sauvignon Blanc, Rapel Valley 1  
A typical, zingy, fresh Sauvignon Blanc with lots of grassy, herbaceous aromas and a touch of lime sorbet, melon and passion fruit.  
Glass, 175ml £5.95 250ml £7.30
- 2 Berri Estates Chardonnay, £21.50  
Australia 2  
Unoaked Chardonnay, the grapes for this fresh, lemony Chardonnay are fermented and matured in stainless steel with no oak contact, the aim is to retain the fresh varietal fruit, crisp, ripe acidity and weight to produce a classic Chardonnay.  
Glass, 175ml £5.95 250ml £7.30
- 3 Da Luca Pinot Grigio, Terre Siciliane £26.35  
Italy 1  
Show aromas of white flowers, pink grapefruit and Cox's apple; the palate displays melon and guava flavours with a crisp acidity and a note of richness.  
Glass, 175ml £6.65, 250ml £8.75
- 4 Liebfraumilch £21.50  
Germany 5  
Zesty and fresh medium/sweet style of wine with delicate floral and citrus notes  
Glass, 175ml £5.95, 250ml £7.30
- 5 Gavi di Gavi, Enrico Serafino £39.75  
Italy 2  
Pale straw-yellow, the wine shows floral and citrus aromas, with a mineral, dry palate.

- 6 Flagstone Word Mouth Viognier £33.95  
South Africa 2  
Ripe watermelon and juicy peach are encased in a delicate hint of spice. Medium-bodied but with a richness to the palate, common to Viognier.
- 7 Sauvignon Blanc, Waipara Hills, £33.30  
New Zealand 8  
Pale green and straw. Melon and tropical fruit bursting with rich ripe fruit. This wine has a wonderful mouthfeel and a bright refreshing finish.

- 8 Chablis Cellier de la Sablière £42.75  
2  
A fuller, fatter style of Chablis, more akin to some wines from the Côte d'Or. The wine is allowed to undergo a partial malolactic fermentation to soften and round the palate.

- 9 Sancerre, Les Collinettes, £42.50  
France 1  
Fermented at low temperature and aged on its lees up until bottling to keep it fresh; this wine is stylish and racy, with the classic blackcurrant leaf and gooseberry character and mineral finish

- 10 Pouilly-Fuissé Les Ancolies £46.95  
France 2  
The wines from the chalky soil of this well-known appellation in the Mâconnais are in great demand for their classic, fuller style.

### ROSÉ WINE

- 11 White Zinfandel, Another Story £21.50  
USA  
Beautiful aromas of fresh strawberries a classic white zinfandel style  
Glass, 175ml £5.95 250ml £7.30

- 12 Belvino Pinot Grigio Rosato £27.50  
Italy  
A delicate pink wine full of fresh, summer-fruit aromas and flavours. The wine is cool-fermented in stainless steel after a brief maceration on the skins to extract sufficient colour.

### RED WINE

- 13 Callia Selected Malbec £28.75  
Argentina 6  
A rich and powerful Malbec that shows a good concentration of blackberry, plum and herbal flavours alongside oak spice from the medium-toast American and French oak employed during the maturation

- 14 Cullinan View Shiraz £21.50  
South Africa 8  
Has a typical deep colour and spicy flavour mingled with sweet vanilla oak from the maturation in small oak barrels  
Glass, 175ml £5.95 250ml £7.30

- 15 Luis Felipe Edwards Merlot £22.95  
Chile 7  
Bright ruby-red, this unoaked Merlot shows black and red cherry, spicy plum and blackcurrant all wrapped up in the velvety textured palate.  
Glass, 175ml £6.15, 250ml £7.85

- 16 Kleine Zalze Cellar Pinotage £27.50  
South Africa 6  
Fruity nose and rich berry flavours with hints of prune and without harsh tannins

- 17 Côtes du Rhône, Gentilhomme £29.50  
France 6  
Robust style using the Grenache, Cinsault and Syrah grape varieties and benefiting from ageing in large oak barrels called 'foudres'

- 18 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Parini £24.50  
Italy 7  
Ruby-red, the nose shows plum and cherry with notes of violet; dry, soft but well-structured with a pleasant long lasting finish of dried fruits and toasted hazelnut

- 19 Marqués de Morano Rioja Reserva £34.25  
Spain 7  
A blend of Tempranillo, Mazuelo and Graciano grapes from the Rioja Alta area. A mature, graceful wine with a long, lingering, velvety style

- 20 Don Jacobo Rioja Gran Reserv £44.75  
Spain 7  
This wine it is smooth and silky with enormous complexity and developed fruit flavours

- 21 Château Cissac, Haut-Médoc £53.00  
France 7  
Black cherry, cassis, mulberry and a hint of spice are accentuated by notes of cedar and vanilla

### CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

- 22 Da Luca Prosecco £29.95  
Italy  
Pear and peach fruit on a lively, yet soft and generous palate.

- 23 Louis Dornier et Fils Brut £38.25  
France  
A light, fresh, vigorously youthful Champagne with a fine, elegant, slightly lemony nose

- 24 Perrier-Jouët Grand Brut £59.25  
France  
Grand Brut has a fine, consistent head of bubbles, which release deliciously floral, slightly honeyed fruit aromas. It shows fresh fruit such as white peach on the palate, and has an elegant finish.

### DESSERT WINE

- 25 Errázuriz Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc, £24.45  
Chile  
Sweet and gently sparkling and pleasing character that recalls honey, raisins, and dried apricots.  
Glass, 125ml £8.25
